A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 95-7

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Gunnison County, Colorado has adopted Resolution 95-7 which established the Gunnison County Trails Commission and which set forth its purpose and policies to provide for preservation of existing trails and plan for new trails within the county; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Gunnison County Trails Commission to appoint additional members; and

NOW, THEREFORE, Resolution 95-7 is and shall be amended by the following change to paragraph 5 and the addition of paragraphs 6 and 7 under Article III set forth as follows:


5. One or two alternate members appointed from qualified applicants that fall into categories listed in paragraphs 1 through 4 above. When a quorum of regular members is not present, an alternate will be seated as a voting member.

6. Good governance requires that a member should attend monthly Trails Commission meetings. Consistent attendance by Commission members at monthly meetings creates a cohesive environment and leads to progress on ongoing projects. Absence of three consecutive monthly meetings by a member requires a review of the situation by the other Commission members. This review may result in a request to the BOCC to remove the member from the Commission.


7. Ex-officio membership shall be given to one named representative from each of the United States Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, Curecanti National Recreation Area, Colorado Department of Transportation, and Division of Wildlife.
