RESOLUTION NO. 2001 - 38**

**A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE PRESERVATION OF OPEN SPACE AND  
GUNNISON COUNTY AGRICULTURAL HERITAGE**

WHEREAS, the citizens of Gunnison County have had a continuing interest in the preservation of open space and our agricultural heritage; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Gunnison County approved a ballot question in 1997 creating the Land Preservation Fund; and

WHEREAS, since the inception of the Land Preservation Fund, the Gunnison Valley Land Preservation Board has worked with various conservation groups to leverage the protection of 4,800 acres within Gunnison County; and

WHEREAS, the Gunnison Valley Land Preservation Board has requested that the Board of County Commissioners place a question on the November 6, 2001 ballot to allow for the establishment of a Line of Credit to be retired through no more than one-half of the future revenues of the Land Preservation Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Gunnison County, Colorado is supportive of this ballot question entitled "1A" on the November 6, 2001 ballot.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners encourage the voters of Gunnison County to approve ballot question 1A which will provide the resources to further the conservation goals of the citizens of Gunnison County.

INTRODUCED by Commissioner Starr, seconded by Commissioner Anderson, and adopted this 23rd day of October, 2001.
