Meeting Minutes

May 7, 2009

The Gunnison County Environmental Health Board conducted a meeting in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Blackstocks Government Center.

01:27 p.m. Call to order by Lull, no quorum. Glazer requested that recommendations be made today and confirmed when a quorum is available. Glazer asked about the next meeting and will we have a quorum for the public hearing? Discussion ensued on replacing members and the timing. Stenson announced Ted Violett's resignation from this board. Request from Glazer for a card and letter be sent to him.

01:35 p.m. Approval of minutes from the July 3, 2008 meeting. Minutes were reviewed. Discussion on the non-use of garbage disposals or grinders for all ISDS permits.

In an email from Parachini a written request to modify the application in bold print that garbage disposals and grinders are not recommended for septic systems. Effluent filters need to be installed on all systems that have disposals or grinders with filtration capacity to 1/16th of an inch. Different types and various sizes were discussed.

Motion by Glazer to recommend approval of minutes with corrections, 2nd Parachini. Motion carried. Glazer recommended Chairperson Lull and Vice-Chairperson Glazer stay through the remainder of this year. Glazer requested staff to contact the administration office to replace missing board members.

01:43p.m. Unscheduled Citizens: Glazer commenced review of current status on Mount Emmons permit appeal.

Stenson reported on the hiring of a state ISDS official. ISDS Regulations have gone to the BOCC and are on the docket.

Glazer requested that Lull write a letter to BOCC to request the review and ultimate approval of the ISDS Regulations be put on the agenda.

Compliance advisory definition was discussed by Stenson concerning the North Valley Subdivision. Other compliance advisories in Gunnison County were discussed.

Antelope Hills Subdivision water problems were discussed.

Crystal Lambert, Assistant to Environmental Health and Building Offices was introduced and asked to brief the board on the Antelope Hills water issues. Health risks to children discussed. Radium levels discussed. Antelope Hills HOA has requested funding to upgrade this system. They are looking at tying into the Dos Rios system.

Stenson explained to the Board of the new enforcement group and how these situations are reviewed.

Glazer indicated that the Coal Creek Watershed Coalition committee reached out to the county to assist on ISDS but they needed the county to reply and acquire the necessary insurance and memorandum of understanding.

02:07 p.m. First meeting of the year. Environmental Health Board reorganization, introduction of Board members, election of Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson, review of Board policies and procedural guidelines.
