02:04 p.m. **Continuation of Public Hearing for Eric and Casey Krawczyk, Lot 35 Panoview Park Subdivision, 324 Crocus Road for a denial of a request for amendment to their current Individual Sewage Disposal System (ISDS) Permit. The request for amendment was denied because the proposed system is a new technology type that must be approved through a public hearing process (ISDS Regulation 10-101).**

Public hearing officially opened. This is a continuation of a meeting from September 3, 2009. All posting locations were met and published in the paper. Eric Krawczyk commenced his update on this application. Eric stated that he has started working with a new engineer, Williams Engineering. As directed by his new engineer, Eric would like to review the state plumbing codes and is requesting more time in order to do so. Eric and his engineer are considering resubmitting the application as a Request for Appeal instead of Special Review. At this time, Eric's engineer is unavailable to meet.

Mr. Krawczyk requested more time so he and his wife may meet with the engineer and review all aspects of this system. March 4, 2010 at 01:40pm for the continuation was set.

Bryndal entered the meeting at 02:25 p.m.

Public Hearing reopened. 02:30 p.m.

With the addition of Bryndal a quorum was determined. Bryndal was informed of the discussion that took place in his absence. Motion by Glazer for continuation of this hearing, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bryndal. Passed

Stenson provided a review of enforcement on Irwin Back Country Guides / Scarp Ridge LLC. Corrections have been completed by the owner, as requested by the attorneys' office. An ISDS permit had been issued for 16 people. The permit includes an engineered gray water system and vault privy. Final inspection on the gray water system has been preformed by staff. The privy is not completed. A LUC permit is not issued at

this time. The attorney's office instructed this permit to be issued prior to issuance of a LUC.

Balch asked if the Town of Crested Butte has approved the design.

Glazer stated that the CCWC is scheduled to meet with Scarp Ridge LLC to discuss the proposed use and design.

System details and components were discussed. Port-a-potties are proposed for use during the 2009/2010 winter season. An engineer design for the vault privy system has not been submitted at this time but concept plans have been discussed with Richard Stenson. Stenson stated that there is a public meeting scheduled for November 20, 2009 at 11:00 a.m..

Bryndal asked if Stenson had sent a review of this system to the Planning Commission. Stenson responded that he had. Balch requested that Stenson make it known that the black water system has not been approved.
