1. 03/21/18, officers cited a 51-year-old female for obstructing a peace officer and obstructing government operations.
2. 03/27/18, Gunnison Community Services officers collected a dog that was running at large within the city of Gunnison and discovered that the animal had been reported as missing to the Gunnison County Sheriff's Office a year ago. The animal and the rightful owner were reunited.
3. 03/27/18, officers arrested a 51-year-old Gunnison female on the charges of criminal attempt, assault in the 1<sup>st</sup> degree, assault in the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, and menacing. Bond for these offenses is set at \$50,000.
4. 03/29/18, North District officers assisted federal agencies with executing a search warrant at a residence within Gunnison County.
5. 03/29/18, North District officers dealt with a large mud slide near the 44 mile-mark of Highway 133.
6. 03/29/18, officers found a dog wondering near Highway 135 2 miles North of Gunnison. The dog was taken to the Gunnison Valley Animal League Shelter for safe keeping. The owners were located.
7. 03/30/18, North District officers served a protection and eviction order at a residence near Somerset.
8. 03/30/18, officers assisted the Colorado State Patrol with a single vehicle accident near the 8 mile-mark of Highway 135. A DUI arrest was made by the Colorado State Patrol.
9. 03/30/18, officers assisted the Colorado State Patrol out of Montrose with an individual who was attempting to elude them. Subsequently a 22-year-old Las Vegas, Nevada male was arrested without further incident.
10. 03/31/18, North District officers responded to an address near Somerset regarding an unattended death. It appears that a 63-year-old Gunnison County male passed away from a preexisting medical issues. This case continues to be investigated.
11. 03/31/18, officers arrested a 27-year-old Gunnison County male for violation of a protection order. The arrest was made at a residence north of Gunnison and went without incident.

1. 03/18/18, officers assisted the Colorado State Patrol with a traffic accident near the 124 mile-mark of Highway 50.
2. 03/19/18, officers responded to a reported possible forest fire near the 84 mile-mark of Highway 149. No fire was detected and it was assumed that it may have been an unregistered controlled burn.
3. 03/19/18, officers and ambulance was dispatched to an address near County Road 48 for a male who had fallen from a roof. The patient was transported to the Gunnison Valley Hospital.
4. 03/19/18, officers served a 33-year-old Gunnison County female with an arrest warrant while she was in custody on a non-related matter. The warrant charges her with menacing in a domestic violence circumstance which is a class 5 felony. She was also charged with reckless endangerment which is a class 3 misdemeanor. There is a no bond stipulation to the domestic violence charge.
5. 03/20/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with a theft circumstance at a business within Gunnison.
6. 03/21/18, officers responded to an address near Ute Lane for a reported disturbance. Subsequent to an investigation a 38-year-old male was arrested on the charges of domestic violence, harassment and child abuse. The individual was taken into custody without incident. This is a no-bond charge.
7. 03/22/18, officers received a report concerning theft from within a residence. Officers are following leads; case remains open.
8. 03/22/18, North District officers were dispatched to an address within Marble for an unattended death; initial investigation reveals that suicide was likely. This case continues to be investigated.
9. 03/23/18, officers arrested a 19-year-old Minnesota male on the charges of 3<sup>rd</sup> degree criminal trespass, illegal possession of marijuana by an underage person, driving while under the influence of drugs, and possession of open container of marijuana. The arrest was made near County Road 17 and went without incident. The bond for the violation is set at \$750.
