1. 06/03/18, officers responded to the Steven Creek Campground for a welfare check on a possible suicidal person. The out-of-state individual was assessed cleared and contact was discontinued.
2. 06/04/18, officers received a report concerning another scam that has resurfaced. The potential victim had received 13 voice mails from March to May instructing her to immediately send money so that she would not be arrested by local law enforcement. Sometimes the money is posed as taking care of an outstanding "fine" sometimes for posting of a "bond". The 69-year-old target did not participate and was not out any money. However, she is quite concerned that other folks may fall victim to this untraceable scam. If you have any questions concerning the validity of orders or instructions by phone, please call law enforcement first.
3. 06/04/18, officers received information that person(s) unknown had broken into the Cemetery Chapel. Nothing other than damage to the door was reported.
4. 06/04/18, officers responded to a location within Saguache County (Vulcan area) for a call relating to an unattended death. Investigations revealed that an 80-year-old male passed away from natural causes. This was a Gunnison County assist for Saguache County.
5. 06/04/18, officers assisted the Crested Butte Marshal's Office with an arrest 3 miles North of Gunnison on highway 135.
6. 06/04/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with a civil assist at the 1000 Block of North Main Street.
7. 06/04/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with a disturbance call neat the 600-block of North Colorado Street.
8. 06/04/18, officers received a report concerning a disturbance in Marble.
9. 06/04/18, officers assisted the Colorado State Patrol by responding to an accident 2 miles North of Gunnison. The male driver stated that he had fallen asleep and wrecked his vehicle. The individual was treated and release.
10. 06/06/18, officers and fire responded to the landfill for a small fire; the cause was not established.

11. 06/07/18, North District officers responded to an address near County Road 265 for a male suffering a medical issue.
12. 06/07/18, North District officers responded to the County Road 3 area for a suspicious circumstance report. It was reported by road construction staff that they observed a disturbance between two adults and a juvenile in a car. Officers and fire personnel responded to the area and searched extensively for the vehicle and it was never located.
13. 06/07/18, officers were dispatched to the Alpine Tunnel Road regarding an unattended death. Investigations revealed that a 70-year-old Colorado Springs male was killed in an ATV accident. It was determined that while attempting to navigate a large snow drift that completely covered the road the side-by-side slid over the road bank and rolled several hundred feet down a steep embankment. The victim had been ejected from the vehicle.
14. 06/08/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with an arrest on Irwin Street.
15. 06/08/18, North District officers responded to a motorcycle accident with injuries at the 34.5 mile mark of Highway 133.
16. 06/09/18, officers responded to Tin Cup for a reported campfire issue late at night. Investigations revealed that the fire was out of acceptable guidelines for stage One Restrictions and a warning was extended.
17. 06/09/18, officers responded to the Gunnison Valley Hospital reference a dog bite report. Investigations revealed that the victim did not want to file a complaint or even a report. It is unknown as to the extent of injury to the 26-year-old female victim.
18. 06/09/18, while on patrol North District officer happened upon a possible mobile domestic disturbance on Highway 133. Investigations revealed that the two individuals involved were having a heated argument but up to that point, no laws had been broken.
19. 06/09/18, North District officers responded to a single vehicle accident with injuries on County Road 12. The Colorado State Patrol conducted the investigation.
20. 06/10/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with an unruly arrestee at the Detention Center.
21. 06/10/18, officers extended a warning on a stage 1 fire restriction violation 1.2 miles North of Gunnison.
