1. 06/25/18, officers received a report concerning a medical issue involving a 55-year-old female from Houston, Texas suffering high altitude sickness in a remote area in the Powderhorn Lake area. Members of the Western Mountain Rescue responded and made contact with the victim. The victim was airlifted and delivered to the Montrose Memorial Hospital.
2. 06/25/18, officers received a report concerning possible domestic violence. This case continues to be investigated.
3. 06/25/18, North District officers received a report concerning a possible protection order violation at a residence within Somerset. Investigations revealed that there was not enough evidence established to prove probable cause.
4. 06/25/18, officers received information concerning a possible domestic violence circumstance. This case continues to be investigated.
5. 06/26/18, officers received a pair of sunglasses that were found on County Road 10.
