## Gunnison County Sheriff's Office Press Release

1. 06/29/18, officers received a complaint of sexual assault. Investigations reveal that the incident took place at a location outside of Gunnison County. This case continues to be investigated.
2. 06/30/18, officers investigated a report concerning animal neglect at the location near Tomichi Heights. This case unfounded.
3. 06/30/18, officers responded to a motorcycle accident near Mile Marker 197 of Highway 50. The lone rider was transported to the Gunnison Valley Hospital with injuries unknown.
4. 07/02/18, officers responded to a business west of Gunnison for a report of a medical concern relative to a 32-year-old woman having a seizure. During the medical assessment it became evident that there had been a dog bite circumstance involving an 8-year-old juvenile male. The woman declined treatment- the juvenile was treated and released from the Gunnison Valley Hospital. The juvenile received injuries and subsequent stitches to his face. A 32-year-old Montrose male was issued a summons for a violation of a vicious dog ordinance.
5. 07/03/18, officers responded to a disturbance call within the Arrowhead Subdivision. Investigations revealed that there was a dispute between residents and contract worker. After officers arrived the circumstance became civil.
6. 07/03/18, officers received a smoke report from the McCabe's Lane area. The concern was unfounded.
7. 07/03/18, officers responded to a domestic disturbance at an address near County Road 13. Subsequent to the call a 19-year-old male was arrested on the charges of harassment, obstruction of telephone communications, domestic violence, child abuse and criminal mischief. These are no-bond charges.
8. 07/03/18, officers responded to the Hartman Rock's area for a trespass complaint. This case continues to be investigated.
9. 07/03/18, officers responded to Gunnison Valley Hospital for a medical call that took place out in the county.
10. 07/04/18, after dark, officers responded to a location near the intersection of Highway 50 and County Road 38 where there was a reported grass fire affecting about a half-acre. The officers

were able to put out a cluster of starts in a short period of time. It was evident that the issue had been caused by fireworks. At this point no one has been tied to the illegal act.

11. 07/04/18, officers assisted the Colorado State Patrol with a disorderly individual one mile north on Highway 135.
12. 07/04/18, officers received numerous firework related violations around the county.
13. 07/04/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with a disturbance call near the 300-block of South 9<sup>th</sup> Street.
14. 07/04/18, officers responded to a reported domestic violence circumstance. Investigations revealed that a crime had taken place and the suspect was no longer in the area. This case continues to be investigated.
15. 07/04/18, officers arrested a 45-year-old Telluride male for driving while under the influence (habitual convictions which is a felony), driving under restraint, careless driving, and obstructing a peace officer. The investigations started from an observation of a no-hands driver. Bond for the offenses is set at \$5,000.
16. 07/04/18, officers responded to a single vehicle accident reported on Highway 50 near the 125 mile-mark. The individual was air lifted to Grand Junction.
17. 07/04/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with a reported disturbance near Irwin Street.
18. 07/05/18, at approximately 2:00 am, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with a burglary incident with Gunnison.
19. 07/05/18, officers arrested a 31-year-old Gunnison female who turned herself in on two Gunnison County warrants for failure to comply. Total bond was set at \$2,250.
20. 07/06/18, officers received a report concerning the theft of a \$350 Smokey Bear sign near County Road 25.
21. 07/06/18, officers and EMS responded to the Arrowhead Subdivision reference an ATV accident with a male party injured. The male was transported to the Gunnison Valley Hospital by ambulance. Investigations revealed that alcohol was a factor and subsequently the 32-year-old male was arrested by the CSP.
22. 07/06/18, officers received a missing hiker report from the Geneva Lake area. A partner of the hiker believed that his friend may have fallen and become injured or deceased after they had been separated. Pitkin County search and rescue as well as West Elk Search and rescue (Gunnison County) were deployed. There was also a helicopter out of Glenwood Springs that launched. After several hours it was discovered that the individual was alright and had made it to his destination.
23. 07/06/18, officers were dispatched to a location within Saguache County regarding a small forest fire. Investigations revealed that the probable start was from lightning. It was established that the blaze was on Federal land and the U.S. Forest Service took over the site.
24. 07/06/18, officers responded to an address within Taylor Park regarding a civil assist.
25. 07/07/18, officers were dispatched to a loud music complaint at a residence near County Road 17.
26. 07/07/18, officers received a medical call at a residence near County Road 16.
27. 07/08/18, at approximately 12:15 am, officers arrested a 27-year-old Colorado Springs male for driving while under the influence of alcohol, driving while license was revoked and failure to drive in a constant lane of travel. The arrest was made at the 18 mile-mark of Highway 135. Bond for the arrest was set at \$750.
