1. 07/09/18, officers investigated a minor fender bender accident at the Rodeo Grounds.
2. 07/20/18, officers responded to an address west of Gunnison for a report concerning a possible protection order violation. There was not enough evidence to support such a claim.
3. 07/20/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Hospital with locating and returning a patient for a mental health assessment.
4. 07/22/18, officers responded to a location on County Road 742 (Taylor River Road) for a medical call.
5. 07/23/18, officers assisted the Colorado State Patrol with a single vehicle rollover accident near the 98-mile mark of Highway 149. The 70-year-old lone female occupant was transported to the hospital by ambulance.
6. 07/23/18, officers responded to a single vehicle rollover accident near the 188 mile mark of Highway 50.
7. 07/23/18, officers received an abandoned bike which found north of Gunnison. Officers were able to return the bike to the rightful owner as it had been registered with the Gunnison Police Department.
8. 07/23/18, officers received a 12 gauge shotgun that a citizen had found within the receding water area of Blue Mesa Reservoir. Officers continue to trace the ownership of the weapon.
9. 07/23/18, officers and Fire members responded to a location near the Hinsdale County line for a reported forest fire. Investigations revealed that the small blaze was all but out. It is believed that this was caused by a lightning strike.
10. 07/24/18, officers received information concerning possible child abuse at a residence within Gunnison County. This case continues to be investigated.
11. 07/24/18, officers and fire responded to the Waunita Hot Springs area for a reported fire within the Double Heart Ranch. The blaze was extinguished by the use of ground crews and a helicopter. The fire was started by lightning and never exceeded an acre in size.
12. 07/24/18, officers received a report concerning a family disturbance at an address in Somerset. The issues were resolved.

13. 07/24/18, officers assisted the Crested Butte Marshal's Office with accepting an emergency commit.
14. 07/25/17, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with a child welfare issue.
15. 07/25/18, officers received a found handgun that had apparently been discovered near Pitkin but turned over to a Chaffee County Deputy. The gun was transferred over to the Gunnison County Sheriff's Office where the ownership will be researched.
16. 07/26/18, at approximately 12:40, officers took a 37-year-old male into protective custody for over indulging in alcohol.
17. 07/26/18, officers responded to a location near County Road 76 for an unregistered controlled fire. In anticipation that the fire ban would be removed the next day a warning was extended.
