1. 06/25/18, officers investigated a possible domestic violence circumstance reported by a witness. Due to a lack of information and supporting evidence charges could not be filed.
2. 06/30/18, officers received a complaint concerning annoying sexual explicit phone messages at a local resident. The traced call appears to have originated out of California and may be scam based.
3. 06/30/18, officers responded to a location near Highway 114 within Saguache County for a possible stage two fire ban violation. Officers made contact with out-of-state individuals who were unaware of fire restriction and had a significant campfire burning. The offenders were extended a warning.
4. 07/02/18, officers received a found wallet but has been unable to make contact with the female owner.
5. 07/05/18, officers received a found cell phone. They were able to return the devise to the rightful owner.
6. 07/06/17, officers conducted a civil assist at a business in the Taylor Park area.
7. 07/08/18, officers received a found wallet but have been unable to make contact with the male owner.
8. 07/08/18, at approximately 6:00 pm, officers received a report that someone was screaming for help within the Hartman Rocks area. Upon the officers initial search no one was found in distress. Officers paged Western Mountain Rescue and a more thorough search was conducted and several outdoor enthusiasts were contact but still, no one was discovered in need.
9. 07/09/18, officers investigated a minor fender bender accident at the Fair Grounds where a vehicle backed into a parked car.
10. 07/09/18, officers responded to the Commissary Hill area for a possible hang-gliding accident. The report was a misunderstanding and the concern was unfounded.

11. 07/09/18, officers were called to the Almont area for a highly disoriented male wandering around. Officers were able to make contact with a 43-year-old subject who was extremely intoxicated. The man was taken into protective custody as an emergency commit.
12. 07/09/18, officers responded to a disturbance and trespass call at the Mesa Campground.
13. 07/09/18, officers were dispatched to a fire ban issue on Bevington Road. Investigations revealed that the concern was unfounded.
14. 07/09/18, officers responded to a bear getting into trash problem in the Country Meadow area.
15. 07/09/18, officers secured two dogs that were running at large in the County Road 13 area and returned them to the rightful owners.
16. 07/09/18, North District officers responded to a motorhome roll over near the 17 mile-mark of Highway 133. There were no injuries.
17. 07/10/18, at approximately 12:00 am, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with a disturbance on North 11ths Street.
18. 07/10/18, officers and EMS responded to a location on County Road 727 for a rider that had fallen from a horse. The 60-year-old male was transported to the hospital.
19. 07/10/18, officers responded to a burglary alarm at a private residence north of Gunnison. Investigations revealed that a possible burglary attempt had been made but the suspect was apparently frightened away by an audible alarm. This case continues to be investigated.
20. 07/10/18, officers investigated a report concerning a minor traffic accident involving a vehicle and mail box cluster for Tomichi Heights.
21. 07/11/18, officers responded approximately 16 miles south on Highway 114 for a medical call involving a 74-year-old Texas woman who had fallen. The victim was transported to the Gunnison Airport Port by ambulance and then from Gunnison by Flight Care.
22. 07/11/18, officers responded to the Tin Cup area for an ATV (All-Terrain Vehicle) accident with an injured 54-year-old Peyton, Colorado female. The victim was airlifted from the area and transported to a Colorado Springs Hospital. Indication was that she had head injuries.
23. 07/11/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with a protection order arrest at Jorgensen Park.
24. 07/11/18, officers received a call concerning stranded dirt bike enthusiast in the Taylor Park area. Western Mountain Search and Rescue was contacted and engaged in the mission at about 9:00 pm and were able to escort the party out of the wilderness by 5:00 am the following morning.
25. 07/11/18, North District officers received a report concerning theft from a residence. This case continues to be investigated.
26. 07/11/18, officers cited a 67-year-old Gunnison County female for tampering with a witness which is a class 4 felony. This case continues to be investigated.
27. 07/12/18, officers received a child custody complaint from a resident within Gunnison County. The circumstance remains civil.
28. 07/12/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with a disturbance call at a local business.
29. 07/12/18, officers collected an abandoned bike neat the one mile mark of Highway 135.
30. 07/13/18, officers received a report concerning possible child neglect at a residence near County Road 76. Officers did not observe evidence of child abuse or neglect and turned the investigations over to Human Services.

31. 07/13/18, officers investigated a reported open burn at an address near Highway 149. Subsequent to the investigation a 40-year-old male was written a \$510 penalty assessment ticket for violation of the stage two fire restriction.
32. 07/13/18, at about 1230 am, officers responded to a disturbance north of Gunnison.
33. 07/13/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with a domestic disturbance.
34. 07/14/18, at approximately 1:00 am, observed a 23-year-old male wander in traffic within Gunnison. The subject was taken into protective custody until he could sober up.
35. 07/14/18, officers responded to an address near Riverfront Drive for a reported open fire. Investigations revealed that a small fire was being monitored by a lone person. Subsequent to the investigation a 56-year-old female was issued a penalty assessment ticket for \$510 for violation of a stage two fire restriction.
36. 07/14/18, officers received a found cell phone and are attempting to return it to the rightful owner.
37. 07/14/18, officers responded to a report of a bear being in the area of Bevington Road. No issues aside from the bear's presence.
38. 07/14/18, officers received a report concerning a possible distress alert in the Yule Pass area. The concern was unfounded.
39. 07/14/18, officers responded to an address near Columbine Road for a possible domestic violence investigation. This case continues to be investigated.
40. 07/15/18, North District Officers responded to a suspicious circumstance reported in Marble. A neighbor had reported that he heard a woman screaming in the next house. After a thorough investigation the concern could not be confirmed.
41. 07/15/18 Officers and Fire, and US Forest Service responded to the Vulcan area for a lightning strike fire that took about 6 acres before it was put out.
42. Officers and Fire responded to the South Beaver Creek area for a small lightning strike fire. It was put out.
43. 07/15/18, Officers and Fire responded to the Parlin Flats for a lightning strike fire which was put out.
44. 07/15/18, there was a lighting strike fire near the Oh Be Joyful area that contained.
45. 07/15/18, there was a fire within the Cebolla area which is being monitored by the US Forest Service.
46. 07/15/18, officers responded to a rollover vehicle accident on Highway 114 near the 14 mile-mark.
47. 07/15/18, North District officers responded to an area within Gunnison County but due east of Crawford for a report of a major fire. Investigations revealed that it was a large fog bank that was mistaken for smoke.
48. 07/15/18, North District officers assisted the Colorado State Patrol with a DUI arrest.
