1. 08/19/18, officers received a report concerning an ATV (all-terrain vehicle) vs. dirt bike collision on the Waunita Pass Road Forest Service Road 763. A 13-year-old Peyton, Colorado female received a broken wrist and a "slight concussion." This case continues to be investigated.
2. 08/24/18, officers arrested an 18-year-old New Mexico male on the charges of driving while under the influence of marijuana, speeding 10 MPH over the speed limit, following too closely and illegal possession of marijuana by an underage person. The arrest took place near the 4 mile mark of Highway 135. Bond set at \$750.

6. 08/28/18, officers and West Elk Search and Rescue rescued an injured hiker near the Geneva Lake area.
7. 08/28/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with searching for a missing juvenile. The individual was located.
8. 08/28/18, officers received a complaint considering possible criminal mischief at a location near County Road 25; case continues to be investigated.
9. 08/28/18, officers assisted the Gunnison Police with searching for a missing juvenile female - found.

10. 08/28/18, officers responded to an address near Meadow Lark Trail for a missing 3-year-old female- child was hiding from siblings and parent- located.
11. 08/29/18, officers received a call concerning a possible missing bow hunter in Game Management Unit 55. A search of the area proved to be fruitless. The following day the missing person called in.
