1. On 11/05/18, officers received a report concerning theft from a residence near County Road 13, Slaughterhouse Road. Several items and a bike was stolen from the front yard.
2. On 11/06/18, officers responded to a structure fire at a residence near Fairway Lane. There was moderate damage to the home. It was investigated by the fire chief and the blaze was determined to be from an electrical short.
3. 11/06/18, North District officers towed several abandoned vehicles in that region.
4. 11/06/18, officers were called to a property dispute near County Road 17. The issues were civil.
5. 11/06/18, officers responded to a car vs. deer accident near the 16 mile mark of Highway 135.
6. 11/06/18, officers responded to the intersection of Highway 50 and Highway 114 for a medical call.
7. 11/06/18, officers responded to an address near County Road 771 (Gold Creek) for a medical call.
8. 11/07/18, officers responded to the 126 mile mark of Highway 50 for a single car rollover accident.
9. 11/07/18, officers responded to an accident involving a vehicle pulling a horse trailer which slid off County Road 740 (Cement Creek Road). Two horses were injured.
10. 11/08/18, officers responded to an address near County Road 730 (Ohio Creek Road) for an unattended death. Investigations indicated that a 67-year-old male had committed suicide.
11. 11/09/18, at approximately midnight, officers received a call concerning a disturbance at a residence near County Road 742. Subsequent to investigation a 43-year-old Almont name was arrested on the charges of menacing and

prohibited use of a weapon. Bond for these charges is \$10,000. Aspects of this case continue to be investigated.

12. 11/09/18, officers responded to the jail for an unruly inmate who was committing criminal mischief and posing a risk to other inmates and staff. This case continues to be investigated.
13. 11/09/18, officers conducted a civil standby at an address near County Road 38 (Gold Basin).
14. 11/09/18, officers were notified that there was a toddler's sized mattress at the landfill with an extensive amount of blood on it. Investigators recovered the evidence and sized that area of the landfill. Within the same day the mattress was delivered to the Colorado Bureau of Investigation for lab testing and the blood was discovered to be animal. As a result officers discontinued the investigation.
15. 11/10/18, officers assisted with a recreational vehicle fire on County Road 40 (Stubbs Gulch).
16. 11/10/18, officers assisted with a car vs. deer accident near the 13 mile mark of Highway 135.
17. 11/11/18, officers responded to a pickup vs. snowplow accident near the 16-mile mark of Highway 135. The driver of the pickup was transported by ambulance to the hospital.
18. 11/11/18, officers responded to a traffic accident near the 147 mile mark of Highway 50.
19. 11/11/18, officers responded to an active burglary alarm at a residence near County Road 76; unfounded.
20. 11/12/18, officers responded to a single vehicle accident at the 170 mile mark of Highway 50.
21. 11/12/18, officers responded to a minor two vehicle accident on Clark Boulevard.
