1. 10/25/18, officers and Western Mountain Rescue searched the Marshal Pass area for a hunter that had been missing overnight. The following day the man was located and returned to his hunting party.
2. 10/29/18, officers were dispatched to an address within Almont for a disturbance. Subsequent to the investigation the officers tracked a suspect to Gunnison and made an arrest for the 22-year-old Gunnison County female on the charges of violation of a protection order and violation of a bail bond condition. The bond for the charges is set at \$10,000.
3. 10/29/18, North District officers observed a 10-day period for a dog that had attacked another dog and was not current on vaccinations. The animal passed the observation period and the owner of the victim animal did not want charges filed. The owner of the suspect animal paid all vet bills.
4. 10/30/18, officers responded to a reported disturbance at a residence near Aspen Lane. There was nothing criminal involved.
5. 10/31/18, officers responded to a single vehicle accident near the 130 mile mark of Highway 50.
6. 10/31/18, officers assisted the Colorado State Patrol with several minor vehicle mishaps on Monarch Pass.
7. 11/02/18, officers arrested a 31-year-old Gunnison County male on two Gunnison County warrants with a bond of \$2,000. There was an additional charge of obstructing a peace officer which also had a separate bond of \$1,000. The arrest took place at a business west of Gunnison.
8. 11/03/18, officers arrested a 35-year-old Gunnison male for DUI and driving a defective vehicle. The arrest took place in Almont and the bond was set at \$750.
9. 11/03/18, the National Park Service in the Great Sand Dune National Park and Preserve requested Western Mountain Search and Rescue for a missing person within the Park.

10. 11/03/18, officers received a found lady's wallet. The owner of the wallet has been contacted.
11. 11/05/18, officers received a found wallet that had been discovered at the chain station on the east side of Monarch Pass. The owner was contacted.
