1. 10/11/18, officers responded to the mile mark 18, of Highway 114 for a semi that had have rolled over into the river. The Colorado State Patrol conducted the investigation.
2. 10/11/18, officers responded to Mile Mark 201 Highway 50 for a single vehicle that had ran over the Edge of Monarch Pass; no injuries.

14. 10/18/18, officers responded to a fatal traffic accident near the 22 mile mark of Highway 114, in Saguache County. The Colorado State Patrol is investigating.
15. 10/19/18, officers responded to the Pitkin area for a gunshot wound suffered by an individual who was cleaning their weapon. There was no indication on how severe the injury was.
