RESOLUTION NO. 2019-14**

**A RESOLUTION REGARDING CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON
GUNNISON COUNTY PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Colorado Liquor Code, at C.R.S. 44-3-901, Unlawful acts-exceptions, at subsection (VII), it is not unlawful for a person who is at least twenty-one years of age to consume any fermented malt beverage or malt, vinous, or spirituous liquor in any public place, other than a public right of way, where consumption of the fermented malt beverage or malt, vinous, or spirituous liquor has been specifically authorized by resolution adopted by the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes that there are certain events at which the Board intends to approve such consumption; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners intends to establish a formal mechanism by which such Board approval can be accomplished from time to time for particular, specific events;


NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Gunnison County, Colorado hereby resolves that:

1. The Board expressly delegates to the County Manager and the Deputy County Manager the authority to approve such consumption of any fermented malt beverage, vinous, or spirituous liquor on County property; and
2. Such approval by the County Manager or the Deputy County Manager shall be accomplished only:
 - a. In writing;
 - b. For a particular, identified specific event;
 - c. No less than seventy-two (72) hours before the event begins;
 - d. With the parameters of the use (i.e. date, time, place, type of alcoholic beverage) specified and limited.
 - e. Identifying the persons responsible for ensuring compliance with the conditions imposed.


