We received the nomination form from the Fairview School Community Association, on the Fairview School. Mac told about a book in the WSC Library on schools in Gunnison County, written by Norietta Rockwell. He will do more research, and get this to Kathy to compile copies for all board members. This school is located up Ohio Creek about 4 1/2 miles. It was purchased in 1964, by this association for \$850. The association is currently interested in any grants available for upkeep on the roof.

He has 73 sites listed as of now. He also told of a cemetery that was moved at Sapinero.
