

Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission  
November 15, 2006

Members Present: Dave Primus, Lyda Hardy, Lynn Card and Laura Easley

The meeting was opened by Dave. Susan Medville, Andy Ruggera, Paul Gery were present and we agreed to use our meeting tonight to let each of them speak to us about their projects and concerns.

Susan Medville is from the Gunnison/Crested Butte Tourism Association. She is working on a project for a Heritage Tour. She is looking for sites around the county to include in the tour. She is putting everything together into a brochure. She has been talking to the property owners on the list that she has put together. She handed out a working draft that showed the properties and the information she has about them. Susan went over the document with us and gave us a brief overview of the draft. They wanted to only include properties that could be accessed with a 2 wheel drive vehicle. She has used lots of different information and sources to put this together. She asked everyone to take it home and go over it and email or call her with any corrections or helpful hints. Her email is [REDACTED] or her phone number is [REDACTED]. Susan asked for some advice about the ranching community and how to approach them so that they realize it is being done in a way that is not offensive to them. She would like to include either a ranch or barns but isn't sure who to talk to. They would not have to let anyone on the ranch if the barn or structure could be seen from the road. She might need to talk to the individual rancher and get their take on how much trouble it would be if some stopped to inquire about the structure. She also wanted to know where the sign for the Great Wall is. Dave gave her directions to find it. Everyone at the meeting agreed that this was a great project and was nice to see the county as a whole included in it.

Andie Ruggera and Paul Gery came to represent the City Historic Preservation Commission. A while back Paul wrote an article for the paper and he and Dave met and went over it and made some changes. We discussed that just because the County HPC is a CLG is doesn't change our application process. It was agreed that the County and City boards would work together on putting properties on the register. We will also try to keep contact between the boards for future projects. Paul is going to attend some of our meetings and keep us posted of the City's meetings.
