Ian has received the funding from the State that they have been working on for the last two years and he thinks they now have it worked out with the County by using the National building codes on this building. He just wanted to encourage us to write a letter to the building department, letting them know how important it is to work on projects like this with the property owner. We agreed to do so but not until we know that Ian has things worked thru with building inspector. It was moved and seconded that Dave will write the letter and get it to Debbie to mail to the building department and the commissioners.

Justin Lawrence came to give us two applications for the register on the Fairview Peak Watch Tower and the Alpine Guard Station. They have done a lot of work on the watch tower. The packets were reviewed by the members of the board. It moved and seconded that the applications meet the required criteria and we would schedule a public hearing for the May meeting. It will be at 5:15 before our regular meeting. Debbie will get the notices in the paper.

Historic Preservation month is coming in May. Debbie brought the signs for the "this Place Matters" campaign. Everyone is to send their article and picture to Debbie so that she can get them to the paper for printing. Paul is going to write an article for the Shopper and the CB papers. He will get those to Debbie for her to type and send on to the paper.

The schools should be on the website by the end of the month. Debbie is getting the picture disc back to Tara at Paragon so she can reload it.

There was no further business to come before the board so Dave adjourned the meeting.
