

Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission
September 15, 2010

The meeting was opened by Dave. The minutes were read and approved. The first item on the agenda was a presentation by Mike Pelletier from the County Mapping Services office. He gave an overhead presentation on what he and Dave have been working on. He showed us a map that is on the County's computer system. They have been mapping all of the historic sites in the County. They have used the State's data base survey that has approx. 4400 sites. Mike showed the board how you can pull up different areas of the map or if you are looking for specific places and information on them you can pull that info up also. The presentation was great and we are now wondering if some of this could qualify for the survey that we need to do for the CLG. Dave is going to talk to Dan Corson about this and see if it would work. At some time in the future it would be good to release some sections of this map to the public. Some of the historic sites are protected and their whereabouts can't be released. Mike gave a great presentation and we will be glad to continue to work with him on this.

The next item on the agenda was the movie night update. Paul told us that he wasn't sure yet what movie they are going to show in October. The library won't show Arizona Dream because of "sex scene". They may just show the parts that were filmed in Gunnison and have a lecture on it. On Nov. 12 & 13 Mark Stiger is giving a talk at the Art Center.

Lee Ann let us know that she did not get the interview done she had scheduled so she will reschedule that for sometime in the future. Paul and Jody did get the interview with the Kincaid's done. Dave took the information to give to Carol for transcribing.

Dave & Debbie let everyone know that when Debbie was working on the budget for next year she came across a figure that she had not put into the budget. It was for mapping services. When Debbie called about it she was told by the finance office that every County office was assigned an amount that was billed out as mapping. Our budget is increased by that amount so it really isn't coming out of our bottom line.

Mike and Dave talked to the County Clerk & Recorder's office where the maps are stored that the board feels needs to be copied. It would take someone in the office to scan the maps. They really don't have anybody extra to help do that. There is a scanner right there in the office so if we had a volunteer we could have them do it. Debbie is going to talk to Gary in the Community Service office and see if it would possible to set that up as a community service work project.

There was no further business to come before the board, so the meeting was adjourned.
