

Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission  
October 20, 2010

Members Present: Lyda Hardy, Lynn Card, Paul Gery, Jody Reeser, Lee Ann Mick

The meeting was opened by Jody. There were no minutes from the previous meeting. Debbie will bring them to the next meeting since she was home sick.

The first item on the agenda was the budget requests update. Jody reported that Debbie has been notified that we have received the full funding for the extra that we requested. Lee Ann and Lyda requested that Commission members receive a copy of the itemized budget.

Paul has typed a copy of the interview with Katherine Emsden and has given it to Jody, who will deliver it to Debbie at the next meeting. The tape of the interview was also delivered with the written interview.

Paul reported on the movie committee. Approx. 65 people attended the October movie. The license for movie showings at the library has been exhausted. Paul is working on getting special permission for showing "Snowbeast", "Arizona Dream", and "Snowball Express." November's movie will be Nov. 13 @ 7:00 pm at the Arts Center and is video of the W Mountain archaeological site with Mark Stiger. There will not be a movie in December. Lyda suggested the January showing of "Snowbeast" may work best at the high school. There is a question of who would run the equipment for the movie. Paul has contracted with Rita Bohn of Third Eye Productions to make copies of a railroad movie and a video on the history of southwest Colorado for the HPC collection. Rikki Santarelli has given Paul more railroad movies to add to the collection. He will also look into getting a copy of the "American Cowboy" from the Guerrieri's. The Gunnison Film Commission has a 5 minute promotional video in 1993 that should be added to the collection. Other films for the collection include the "Gunnison Navy", collections of home movies from various local families, and one coming from a tourist that is a railroad enthusiast. Anne Steinbeck and friends will, again, review "Gunnison on Parade" for recognizing and recording people in the film. Paul would like to know if the thank you letters have gone out yet? He would like to add 4 more recipients to the list: Russ Lallier, Rikki Santarelli, Mac McGraw, and Frohm Newton.

Lee Ann reported on the school project. The 4<sup>th</sup> grade team is thinking of ways to spend \$500 on local history. There has been a suggestion of doing a field trip to WSC with Mark Stiger. Lee Ann will continue to work on this.

Lee Ann will need the video camera next Monday at 4pm for her interviews. She will call Dave to see if he has it.

There was no further business to come before the board so the meeting was adjourned.

An addendum was added. There will be no meeting in December and we need to write a letter of thanks to Laura for her service.
