

Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission
April 21, 2010

Members Present: Dave Primus, Lyda Hardy, Jody Reeser, Lynn Card, Laura Easley, Nick Lypps, Paul Gery

The meeting was opened at 5:15 by Dave. The minutes were read. Dave asked that the wording in paragraph 6 was changes to say "could have been" instead of "this was". An "ed" was added to the work talk in paragraph 4. It was moved and seconded that the minutes be approved as corrected. The motion passed.

The first item on the agenda was our guest, Dan Corson. He let us know that he was here to do our formal evaluation. He gave a presentation on the CLG orientation and public hearings. He also talked to us about the things that we needed to follow-up on. The Survey was talked about and we need to apply for a grant to help hire someone to come in and tell us how it would be best to survey Gunnison. He also, gave Debbie some suggestions of people to contact for information regarding who they hired to do the surveys. The grant is due by Nov. 15th and he will forward the application to us as soon as it comes out. We also need to spend all \$600.00 of the grant that we received from the State. Debbie is going to check on the amount of Nick's costs and then work on spending the balance of that so she can get everything turned into Dan. He suggested that we visit other boards to see how they handle the surveys, etc. There are only 3 boards that function with volunteers for their board members. Those are Gunnison, Kiowa County, and LaVeta. It would be good to make visits to those boards also. Dan told us that there are several different people at the State office that we can contact to come over and do presentations on different programs that we would find useful for the items we are working on.

The next item on the agenda was Historic Preservation month and what we were going to do finalize our plans for the movie showings. Paul & Lyda let us know that we could only show the shorts at the Art Center or we could show the other movies at the Library. The library doesn't hold as many as the Art Center, but it was decided it would be better to have a full house at the library as we could show what we wanted to there. Paul is going to double check with the Arts Center and he and Lyda will come up with a final plan. It was agreed that they needed to have another meeting on May 4th at 5:15 to let everyone know the final plan and set up who could help out when.

As there was a time crunch for several board members, the other items on the agenda were tabled until the next meeting. As there was no further business to come before the board, Dave adjourned the meeting.
