April 20, 2011

Jody opened the meeting at 5:15. Minutes were read and approved as corrected.

The first item on the agenda was May Historic Month. Patti has made a power point presentation that she has given to the kids at the schools. She spoke to Gloria Wagner's leadership class at the High School. They have set it up for the kids to take a survey this week at the school asking about what they would like to know about the history of Gunnison. She will coordinate with Lee Ann to also talk to the grade school kids. She is going to CB to go over it with Glo Cunningham so they can incorporate it into the CB schools also. It was decided that in the essence of time that we should have a sub committee to take care of the details and get the information to the paper. Patti and Jody will be on the committee to work the details out and proceed as needed.

An update on the meeting for the Clark property was given. Lee Ann & Paul gave report on the meeting they attended for the property. Jody gave a short summary on the property and different buildings. They have asked Jody as an architect to help do assessments on the property. Dr. Brooke Moran is taking on the project to give them an opinion on how to put together the best use of the property.

Paul gave an update on the films. Paul thought we should show the documentary that Mike Brooks did on ranching in the valley for May. Paul is going to talk to the Arts Center about showing the movies this summer since the libraries windows are so bright and it stays light longer. He will see what he can work out with them and let us know at that the next meeting.
