

Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission
Regular Meeting
April 18, 2011

Board Members Present: Jody Reeser, Lyda Hardy, Patti Bippus, Lynn Card, Paul Gery, Nick Lypps, Lee Ann Mick

The meeting was opened directly after the public hearing by Jody.

We had a presentation by Tina McGuinness and Jeff Walker from Partners. They were giving us an update on the progress of the 8th Street School. Jody is working with Partner's as a consultant and she gave us an overview of the building. Jeff gave a wonderful presentation about the building and the revitalization project that they are working on and the different steps they will take. He also covered the "Adopt a Brick" campaign that they are getting ready to launch. Tina spoke about the partner's program. Their building will be also opened up to be used not only by Partner's but also by the community.

The minutes were read and approved. The first item on the agenda is to finalize the Public Hearing. The board discussed the American Legion packet. It was moved and seconded that the packet would be forwarded to the Commissioners for final approval to be put on the register. Debbie will get the information to the Commissioners and get it put on their agenda. She will let the board know when it is going to be presented.

The Colorado Preservation workshop was May 13th. We had a good attendance and those who attended the workshop thought it went well and Debbie thanked everyone for their help with it. We also received a post card from Dan Corson thanking us for helping put on the workshop. He also mailed a CD with the last power point presentation that he did not have with him that day. Anyone interested is welcome to the CD.

Historic Preservation month was discussed. Patti has been working hard on gathering the information from the schools and working on the questions. Patti put together a flyer that will be in the paper. Jody is going to send that off next week to the paper. Jody and Patti have talked to the paper and they have agreed to put our questions and answers in once a month for the next year.

Jody let us know that she has not heard back from the lady on the window workshop. So that was tabled until further notice.

Paul gave us a film update. He has still not heard from anyone about showing Snow beast. Paul has 2 others to get permission to show. The Art Center has agreed to show the movies this summer.

Debbie let the board know that she had been approached about putting just the Parlin post office on the register. Not the actual building just the PO boxes and counters. Debbie discussed it with Dan Corson over the phone and when he was here. After Dan reviewed our

packet it was agreed that there was a lot of iffy ground and it would mostly likely not work to only put the post office items on the register without the whole property being on it. The owners of the Parlin store do not wish to have the building placed on the register so at this time we will go no further with this.

Lyda asked the Debbie to order a book, "Access for Dummies", so that she and Paul can set up a data base on the computer, for the film project that Paul has been working on. Debbie will get that ordered.

There was no further business to come before the board so the meeting was adjourned.
