

Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission

Public Hearing was opened by Jody Reeser on the Clark Ranch house. Debbie confirmed that the meeting had been publicized in the Gunnison Country Times for the last 2 weeks. Jody presented the property up for nomination. Butch Clark who is the owner of the property stood and gave a brief summary of the property. Jody asked for questions from the board. It is currently being transferred from one owner to another and the board felt like they could go ahead and put it on the register and then if it changes we would deal with that at the time it happens.

The board talked about developing a flyer/handout to give to the public to inform them about the good qualities of putting a property on the register.
