Jody Opened

Russ moved to approve minutes, Ruth seconded.

Jody explained that Debbie had a discussion with Dan Corson and that if we don't focus on doing our CLG Survey we could lose our CLG status. Lyda understands the survey to be whatever division of historic site inquiry we want, a specific area or specialty. Jody thought it was more general, that we were to have a company do all the historic sites in our County. We need to clarify with Dan. Lyda asked if we can use what is in the green file cabinet, or info we got from when the City did one, or the info on the County map site. No one is exactly sure where the file cab or map site info came from, from the state? How often does this survey need to be done? Which grant exactly and when is it due? Russ suggested Patti may be able to help Jody in putting together the grant paperwork. Jody will forward questions on to Debbie for clarification. Lyda then suggested the Main St project may be able to qualify as what we do for our survey. Everyone agreed that would be good. Jody asked Russ for a description and goal of what they've been working on for the Main St project. Russ said the goal was to put together a searchable database containing, each address, each occupant, and each owner for as long as they can go back. Jody understood the original goal was to do a historic picture and description for each building to display, so it may be two different related projects. Due to Debbie's CLG discussion Jody suggested we put the Main St project on hold for this month so we can organize what the CLG Survey project is and how it could be part of the Main St projects so no one's time gets wasted in doing things twice. Ruth and Russ were both very upset about putting their work on hold for the month. Russ told us that his meeting with BOZAR went fine and that when we are ready to work on the CB Elk Ave. info that someone could coordinate with molly at the Town of CB.

Jody asked if there was anything we wanted for the Debbie's budget request. Lyda inquired if there was any money still in the budget for the transcribing of the oral histories? How much has been paid out? Do we need to keep this and if so do we need to evaluate the current system? Jody will ask Debbie for an email of the current transcribed histories and she will print them out to see our progress at the next meeting. Russ suggested we ask if there a need to request money for our grant, if it requires a grant match. There was discussion on if we needed money for the Main St project and Russ suggested we look into money for someone to do data entry for the gathered data into a computer database.

Russ spoke with Patti and she is working on a grant with the Boomers and Beyond for a history project and would like to request our support. We agreed we will need more info on what she needs and we can write a letter.

There was no further business to come before the board so Jody adjourned the meeting.
