Russ suggested that we buy metal signs to put on the outside of the building. Jody suggested that we start with the wood signs and then after we see how the feed back is from the business owners, work towards the metal plaques. Lee Ann and Jody will work on a prototype for the sign.

The movie project Lyda will work on with Paul Gery.
