

Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission  
February 19, 2014

Members Present: Jody Reeser, Justin Lawrence, Lee AnnMick, Lynn Card, Russ Lallier

The meeting was opened by Jody. The minutes were read and approved as read.

The first item on the agenda was guest Audrey Miller. She was not present but Jody told us that the Boomers wanted to talk about the audio/video interviews. Their list has gotten very long and they are having trouble getting all the interviews. Jody will contact them about meeting in with them April.

Justin Lawrence is our new board member, he was introduced and he gave us a brief history on himself.

Jody brought us information on Jorgensen/Clark cabin. She received an email from Don Graham regarding the historic designation of the cabin in the future. It is owned by the Gunnison Valley Housing Foundation and will be managed by Gunnison Nordic. They wanted to put a wood stove in and wanted to be sue we didn't think it would compromise the possibility of listing on the register later. The motion was made that we don't have any objection to a wood stove being installed on a possible future listing of a historic site. It was passed unanimously.

Jody has been playing phone tag with Mr. Phipps at the school in regards to setting up the sign making for the downtown project. She will keep working on that with him. Young at Heart and Boomers said that we could put up the posters but they doubted that anyone would walk up to the wall and look at it. They would like it in a much smaller format for the table top. The problem with that is that we have a lot of info and when you put on smaller paper it is hard to read. We talked about going and taking the sheets we have and having a get together with them before or after their meal to talk to them about it the different changes downtown. We thought maybe we could work it May's Historic Preservation month. We will talk more about that next month.

We received a packet from the United States Department of Agriculture regarding the selling of the Crested Butte office and ranger's residence. There will be a meeting March 13 at 10:00 am in Gunnison, at the Forest Service conference room to sell the Gothic Ranger Station. That meeting will include Bozart in CB. The Gunnison office on Colorado Street is being considered to be removed from the National Register. We have been given the opportunity to weigh in on this. It was the bomb shelter in the bottom of the building and that is the most draw to it. It was decided to table that to the next meeting to mull it over. It was moved and seconded that on the Crested Butte issue the board agreed to defer to BOZART.

Jody gave a brief report on the State Saving Places Conference that she attended in Feb. She attended lots of great classes and got some great reference materials that she will be glad share.

Justin and Russ are going to get together and work on updates that need to be done to the web site. Then they will get these to Debbie.

We will talk about historic preservation month at the next meeting. Russ will be giving a presentation on his 4th movie and maybe we could work that into preservation month also.
