

Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission
April 16, 2014

Members Present: Jody Reeser, Lyda Hardy, Ruth Dolezal, Lee Ann Mick, Russ Lallier, Justin Lawrence , Lynn Card.

The minutes were read and approved with corrections.

The first item on the Agenda is Dan Corson's presentation. He gave us an overview about being a CLG. He gave us a slide show about the CLG and requirements. Dan left the disk with Debbie for anyone to reference back to. Dan met with Debbie and went over the records before the meeting. Dan went over the survey information and helped us formulate a plan. There was much discussion about doing a grant to get someone to do the research of what is available in the County to survey and what has already been surveyed. It was suggested that we call and talk to Liz Blackwell. Debbie and Jody will do this together. Dan also gave us some ideas about what to include on our website.

The next item agenda was the May preservation plan. Lee Ann suggested that we approach Boomer's and find out if we can set a time in May to meet them. Lee Ann will get this together and let us know.

The next item on the agenda was the application on the cemetery to be put on the register. The owner of the property has not yet signed it because some of the relatives are worried about the public going to the cemetery. Lee An will call Steve Cadwell, who is the relative that is concerned and talk to him about this to see if we can get this resolved.

The board voted in support of the Forest Service office on Colorado Street, being taken off the National eligibility list. It was voted on, with 4 votes opposed, two abstained and Justin didn't vote. Justin told the board that the Forest Service has already received notice from SHPO that it has been accepted.

On the matter of the Tomichi Mill it was determined that Tomichi Mill was not found eligible by SHPO. The motion was made and seconded to say yes to concurring with site not being eligible. It was voted on with 6 yes and 1 abstained.

It was decided that we need to advertised for someone to transcribe the oral interviews. We need to run an ad thru work force and request resumes and bring back to the next meeting.

We need to hold an exterior alterations public hearing on the Ohio City Hall. It will be at our meeting. On April 30 at 5 pm the board will meet to go look at the building. The public hearing will be on May 21 at 5:00 pm. Debbie will advertise it in the paper.

Russ is putting a film together of the tearing down of courthouse. Russ is working on the web page and wants to take pictures of the board members.

Justin brought up that the GCC don't want to put County properties on the register. He feels that we should go before the board and let them know that we need them to put the building on the register. Also, we need to let them know that we should have been involved in the process. Dan suggest we have a list of all County building and ask them to put on the ones we want on the register and put it in the form of a letter. Justin has a letter he has started and will continue to work on it and then present it as a group. Then have the letter presented at the County commissioner's meeting. LeeAnn called a motion to the above fore mentioned and the motion was amended to say that everyone signs the letter. It was voted on with 8 yes and no opposed.. Justin will send out email next week.

There was nothing else to come before the board, so the meeting was adjourned.
