

## **Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission**

Dave opened the meeting and the group discussed the minutes from the last meeting. Jody made a motion (2<sup>nd</sup> by Justin) to approve minutes. It was approved unanimously.

Dave told everyone about a visit from Jennifer Charles, Endangered Places Program Director, Colorado Preservation, Inc., on September 22<sup>nd</sup>. For sites designated as Endangered Places, they publicize the situation and help write grants.

Mike showed the group the annual work plan that the group had asked he write-up at the last meeting. The group felt it was fine as written.

Dave said that he has not heard from anyone on the Tenderfoot Mountain issue and that he had no updates.

Regarding the survey project, Justin stated that he received the RFP proposal from Russ Forest and that it didn't make sense to use that model given the simplicity of the project.

Mike described progress to date on updating the HPC website on the County's web page. Jody asked for editable forms for landmark nomination. The group asked to have short member bios added to the site. They asked Katherine to shut down the Paragon website when she is ready. Dave said he would help with the process and will write a thank you letter. Mike will send a draft write-up about the Commission to Jody and she will fine tune it.

Jody said she has facilitated a WSCU intern to spend 15 hours analyzing Sanborn maps for the downtown project. She also has another intern lined up to spend 15 hours cataloguing old books in Blackstocks.

Justin said the Fairview Lookout now has windows and the siding and roof are finished.

Dave said he will do another Blue Mesa talk on November 18<sup>th</sup>.

Jody described Butch Clark's desire to seek landmark status for his barn at the Cold Harbor Ranch on Hwy 50 east of Gunnison. Jody will submit the notice for the paper and Mike will post the property.

Jody said she is performing a historical assessment of the Johnson Stage Stop, located on BLM land near Red Bridge, southwest of Powderhorn.
