Jody open the public hearing and stated that the proper notification was done for the Coldharbour Barn Landmark application. She described the merits of barn and why it deserves landmark status. She stated the intent is to apply for grant money to rebuild the second story. The public hearing was then closed.

Jody opened the regular meeting. Lynn made a motion (2<sup>nd</sup> by Justin) to approve the minutes as written. It was approved unanimously.

The Coldharbour Barn application was discussed. Lee Ann made a motion (2<sup>nd</sup> by Lynn) to recommend the BoCC approve the landmark designation for the site. It was approved unanimously with Jody abstaining and Dave Primus voting via proxy.

Jordan Cooper introduced herself, stating her interest to join the HPC board.

The group discussed the issues associated with the Mountaineer site. Currently, WSCU is waiting on AT&T to provide more information on the project.

The group discussed the meeting with Mark Rodman who is the new CLG state representative. He encouraged the HPC board to stay involved in the Mountaineer approval process to show local support for the site.

It was stated that Russ Lallier has resigned his position with the Board due to timing conflicts with his new job. The BoCC will be designating new appointees for commission in early 2016.

Justin described delays on the survey project due to turnover at the state historic offices.

Jody passed out website text for the group to review. She will send a digital version to everyone to make it easier for comments to be shared.

Jody described how the intern working on the downtown project made a little progress but has stopped working on the project. The history intern is making excellent progress including a spreadsheet showing the information.

The group supported Dave Primus's request to attend the upcoming Saving Places Conference.

The group asked Mike to provide an updated copy of landmarks to the Building Department, submit the Cold Harbor Barn application to the BoCC, and retrieve the HPC's email and mail.

The meeting adjourned at 6:15.
