Justin opened the meeting. Lee Ann (2<sup>nd</sup> by Jody) made a motion to approve the minutes with a name spelling correction. It was approved unanimously.

The group discussed that History Colorado has requested the HPC comment on the Johnson Stage Stop application for the National Register. The group asked Mike to respond with letter supporting the application and a request to change the application to reference the trail in the area as a possible variant of the North Branch of the Spanish Trail rather than referencing the trail as the North Branch of the Spanish Trail.

Dave said there was no Mountaineer site update and Lyda said they are continuing to work on the Downtown project. Jody said the interns have finished with the end of the school term and that there is a good chance for more interns in the fall.
