Justin opened the meeting. Lee Ann (2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave) made a motion to approve the minutes with a correction identified by Justin. It was approved unanimously.

Justin had a conference call with the state (History Colorado) regarding the survey. They worked out a few minor changes to the project. He said the state is very pleased with the product and want to use it as model project for others to follow. Justin asked Mike to handle payment of the project.

Justin gave an update on the Mountaineer site. Western State Colorado University got a grant to provide signage for better management of the site. He also described a document describing a proposed change regarding the FCC and section 106 reviews. He will email the document to the group for review and to determine if the HPC should comment.

Jody described the wrap up work by an intern on the downtown project and that he might be available in the fall for more work. The group discussed the possibility of getting high school students interested in downtown history research work.

Justin asked Mike to send him a copy of the Johnson Stage Stop letter that he was asked to send to the State on behalf of the HPC.

Justin described a bit more of the damage to the Alpine Tunnel area rockwork and the road damage. He said due to lack of available turnarounds, the access is closed at the bottom on the west side. Access is still available from the east side of the pass however.

Justin said he got admin access to the HPC Facebook page after meeting with Russ Lallier. The group expressed concern that non HPC member (Russ) has admin access to the page. Justin and Jordan said they would look into the matter.

Lee Ann and Lyda announced that HPC file cabinet is now organized. Their next step is to catalog all the oral histories but the group asked Mike to backup the discs first.
