

Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission

Justin opened the meeting and the group reviewed the minutes from the last meeting. Jody made a motion (2nd by Dave) to approve the minutes. It was approved unanimously.

Abigail Sanocki and Jonathan Hedlund from ERO Resources Corporation attended by phone and gave a brief overview of the Historic Resource Survey Plan project. The group discussed the merits of the plan, the value of historic research following a clear path, and how the plan would be used into the future. The commission asked Mike to have the plan added to the HPC website. Questions from the public sparked discussions regarding how to get people interested in pursuing the historic register and a discussion on historic tourism.

Jody started a discussion regarding potential internship work for WSCU students. Items discussed included finding old photos of Gunnison, scanning and cataloging Lynn's collection of grave stone pictures, transcribing oral interviews and converting them to youtube videos, and helping with historic structure assessments.

The group discussed the budget for the coming year and what projects might need additional funding. The group asked Mike to request \$300 additional for travel lodging and \$50 additional for travel meals to more accurately reflect prices.

Lee Ann asked the group for better pictures of the Gunnison Hotel to be used in the Downtown project.

Dave described new information from Bob Easterly regarding the location and history of the Boulevard cemetery. He also described a D.R.G milepost sign that was found on the Cold Harbour property and how it will be cleaned up and used at the museum.
