Justin opened the meeting and the group reviewed the minutes from the last meeting. Lyda made a motion (2nd by Lee Ann) to approve the minutes. It was approved unanimously with a correction.

Jordan gave the group an update on the City Shop building research that her and Jody have been doing. Justin said he would set up a meeting for those interested in this project to strategize on options. Some of the options discussed included grant options, alternate locations for new shop, the endangered places list, move and rebuild stones in new location such at the Pioneer Museum, save south wall, or just save southern portion of building.

Jody sent an email updating the group about the CLG survey grant. The grant application did not get submitted for the January deadline. Our options are to trim down the scope and get ERO's price for that and then see if we have the 25% match in our budget for an April or October grant submittal or wait until next January for the 0% match round again.

Lee Ann updated the group on the Fairview Schoolhouse. The association managing the site found insurance and is hoping that revenue from events at the site in the coming year will make it viable to run in the future.

Lee Ann said that she and Jody had an interesting interview with Richard Guerrieri which include his experience working at the old City Shop building.
