

Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission

Blackstock Government Center – February 15, 2017

Dave opened the meeting and the group reviewed the minutes from the last meeting. Lee Ann made a motion (2nd by Jordan) to approve the minutes. It was approved unanimously.

Mike told the group about the City preparing the RFP to demolish the old City Shop building and his meeting with Russ. Dave told the group that Justin was having a meeting on 2/16/17 to discuss the issue. Lyda made a motion (2nd by Lee Ann) to have Mike call the city and get on the Council's agenda pending the result of Justin's meeting on 2/16/17.

The group discussed Jody Reeser's request for help on the projects she has been overseeing. Lyda and Lee Ann said they would work with the interns on the downtown project. The group decided to ask the Board of County Commissioners at the next budget cycle for matching funding for the CLG survey grant in case the next January no match grant request was denied.

Mike provided the information to the group regarding the Crested Butte Land Trust's request to put the Glacier Homestead on the local historic register. The group asked Mike to schedule it for the next meeting and Jordan said she would review the application to suggest improvements to the application.

Mike presented CDOT's request for comments from the HPC regarding their upcoming paving project along Hwy 50 west of the Blue Mesa dam. Their findings stated that the project would not damage any historic resources and the HPC concurred. The group asked Mike to send CDOT a copy of Rainbow Route as Dave and Mike had mapped it within Gunnison County and to request that if they find historic resources during the project that they share the information with the HPC.

The group then discussed funding a new oral history transcription vs. keeping the money for the downtown project. The group asked Mike to check on the County requirements for the HPC to hire a contractor. Dave suggested that anyone interested in working on the project should try it for 10 minutes or so to see how much time the transcription might take.

Lee Ann made a motion (2nd by Lyda) to postpone the election of a chair person to the next meeting.
