Justin opened the meeting and the group reviewed the minutes from the last meeting. Lee Ann made a motion (2<sup>nd</sup> by Lynn) to approve the minutes. It was approved unanimously.

The group discussed the History Colorado's request to hold a Certified Local Government meeting in Gunnison. The meeting would be about 3 hours and have about 30 people. The group decided to pursue this and Lyda offered to be the point person. Mike said he would be able to find an appropriate meeting room using County facilities.

Justin updated the group on the meeting with the Gunnison City Council to discuss the fate of the old City Shop building. He said there was good support from the newspaper and the public and that there will be additional meetings to discuss the issue.

The group asked Mike to check on the cost of cast iron landmark plaques from Healy Plaques. The group wanted to discuss sign options at the next meeting.

Justin said the State Historical Preservation Office approved plans for rebuilding the Alpine Wall.
