Justin opened the meeting. Lee Ann (2<sup>nd</sup> by Jody) made a motion to approve the August meeting minutes. It was approved unanimously.

Jody announced that she was recently appointed to the review body that designates historic structures at the national level.

Jody and Justin described their trip to the historic Town of Crystal. There was about 30 structures originally and about 11 remain. There are 3 or 4 owners of those buildings with one owning most of them. The State wants to do a resources survey as a first step and the group discussed the pros and cons of administering it. Jody and Justin said they would both be able to work on it. The group was excited about the possibilities of this project and the quality of the remaining structures. Jody made a motion to have the Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission apply for a CLG grant to do a historic resources survey. It was approved unanimously.

Lee Ann said she has found a good image for the Art Center sign and is working with Off Center Designs on the project.

Dave said he has been helping the National Park Service and will do a tour of the Lola town site that has recently come above water as the Blue Mesa Reservoir level drops.

The group discussed Justin going to the Saving Places Conference this year. Jody said she will likely go as well but not use HPC funds since she used them last year.
