Dave presented his work on identifying buildings shown in the 1882 birds eye map of Gunnison that still exist today. He used Assessor information and drive by inspections to make the determinations. He also described how he and Mike used this map and other resources to determine that Richardson's first cabin in Gunnison was located near the gas pumps at Standard Tire on Tomichi.
