Justin opened the meeting. Minutes were not acted on because not enough members present were at the meeting in question.

Russ Lallier gave a short presentation regarding his website that provides historic building information throughout the county. He requested that the board contribute a small amount so that he can keep the site operating.

The group was enthusiastic about the site, but wanted Mike to check with County Manager and Attorney about what type of projects should be funded and how to deal with future historic related project requests. The group wanted links to be setup between Russ's site and the existing HPC website. The group said they would act on his request at the next meeting.

A discussion was held regarding downtown signage. Mike said the Art Center (communication with Hap Channell) was interested in a large, high quality historic sign for the building, in lieu of the one the HPC has been working on.

There was desire to talk with City Council about a sign program before proceeding with the existing sign format. Lee Ann said she would initiate that discussion. Some of the ideas discussed included maintaining consistency between signs, getting City of Gunnison participation, and consider a large mid-block sign describing the opposite street block. Regarding the current HPC sign design, the group also gave Mike their preference for the wiggly border version.
