

Gunnison County Historic Preservation Commission

Online Zoom meeting (due to COVID 19 virus precautions) – March 17, 2021

Jody brought the meeting to order and presented a list of possible outreach buildings and put the document “Potential Historic Properties” into the Microsoft Teams folder “Historic Properties & Development Sites Outreach”. The group was asked to review and comment on the document.

Jody presented a new version of a press release for the historic agriculture award. Several comments were made and Jody said she would present it to the HPC.

The group looked over the suggested changes to the HPC resolutions (Microsoft Teams document – “031721 Proposed Resolution Modifications Revised” in folder “Commissioner Reference”). It was suggested to rethink the portion on the uses of HPC funding to cover public vs non-public uses. Also, the group wanted to rethink the portion on alteration certificate with the notion that an electrical outlet or hose bib requires a building permit.

The group then discussed possibilities for the next survey effort. Jody created a document (Microsoft Teams document – “Survey Priority List - 031721” in folder “2016 Survey Plan”) and asked people to edit it. The group discussed the possibility of Somerset for a survey.

Shelley talked with Jake Jones of the Crested Butte Land Trust about historic designation for the Glacier Homestead. She said he will review the information that CBLT had gathered years ago.

Shelley and David spoke with Kathleen and the owner about the Hartman Castle. The group discussed the poor condition of the roof and possible incentives that would interest the owner.
