Jody opened the meeting and the group discussed minutes from February 16, 2022. LeeAnn (2<sup>nd</sup> David) made a motion to approve. They passed unanimously.

Jody described progress on the downtown sign project. Sign Guys and Gal will do a version for \$28 for the group to review. The group discussed Webster Hall being a good candidate for the next sign. LeeAnn said she would work on getting the City Hall sign installed.

Mike said he would work on the HPC resolution changes by the next meeting.

The group discussed the Somerset grant not being funded and decided to resubmit for a future grant submission. Kathleen said she would send a note to Somerset folks about the grant not being funded.

Next, the group discussed the Richard/Phyllis Guerrieri ranch as a good candidate for the next Historic Agricultural Honors program. LeeAnn said she would work on a nomination. Jody and Mike will look for the ad that was done last year. David said he could help with this project.

Jody said she attended a CLG webinar last month focused on evaluating a building's remaining historic integrity. The main point was to consider the remaining integrity of key building features.

Jody then said she plans on taking Western students on a trial walking tour of Gunnison. Western is planning on creating a walking tour phone app for downtown Gunnison.

Kathleen brought up Larry McDonald's email to the group and how the two groups can help each other. She was particularly interested in the potential for groups to adopt a building at the museum and help with care of the building and its contents.

Addendum:

Jody presented the updated Ag Honors Nomination request newspaper ad to the board via email during the week of 4/4/22, along with request for approval of running the ad in the Gunnison Times, Gunnison Country Shopper, and the CB News 2 times in the month of April and 1 time in the month of May. The cost for Gunnison Times = \$50.76/wk, Shopper = \$38.40/wk, CB News = \$66.14/wk. It was approved with 5 yes votes via email.
