Regular Meeting – November 20, 2024

Minutes were not available for the group to review.

The group discussed Zoe utilizing the State's scholarship program for the State Conference. Mike will work with Zoe to get the application submitted and help her with the County travel expense forms.

There will be no meeting in December for the HPC.

The group discussed the desire to plan a Somerset history project acceptable to the Board of County Commissioners in 2025, incorporating the work that has been accomplished to date.

LeeAnn said she expects to have the Ag award finished after Thanksgiving and is working with the Allens and Johnathan Houck on appropriate time. Afterwards it will be put in the newspapers.

LeeAnn said she has the write-up on Webster Hall for a sign but needs to find a better photo of the building. The group discussed possible sources for a better picture.

The group asked Mike to get Zoe and others easier access to the HPC files in Microsoft Teams. Note: since the meeting, Mike has worked with the IT Department and they have created a Microsoft OneDrive site that works on internet browser rather than the Microsoft Teams app.

The group discussed whether the United Church of Christ building in Crested Butte would need a separate designation beyond the historic district to get more access to funding. The answer was probably not. Jody and Shelley provided documents that described the issues in detail.

The group discussed possible projects for 2025 and the budgetary constraints. The group decided to continue the discussion in January.
