



Press Release for 11-26-2019 through 12-02-2019

****If a defendant is charged with a crime in any of the following incidents, it should be emphasized that the charge is merely an accusation and the defendant is presumed innocent until or unless proven guilty****

- 11-29-19 Deputies responded to the Jail for a medical call involving an inmate who appeared to be having a seizure. Medical professionals observed and examined the inmate. Deputies issued this inmate a citation for false reporting to authorities.
- 11-29-19 Deputies responded west of Gunnison to assist CSP with a motor vehicle accident that occurred on Hwy 50 mile marker 136. The ambulance transported one injured patient to the hospital.
- 11-29-19 Deputies responded west of Gunnison to assist CSP with a separate non-injury accident that occurred where traffic was stopped for the first accident. The driver in this accident was unable to stop and rear-ended the car in front of him. This driver was issued a citation for following too closely.
- 11-30-19 Deputies responded west on Hwy 50 for a report of a chimney fire. The homeowner was able to get his chimney fire out with minimal damage to the chimney.
- 11-30-19 Deputies responded west of Gunnison for a welfare check on a dog who had been outside and barking for four hours. Deputies were able to locate the animal's owner and cleared the scene.
- 12-01-19 Deputies received a call of a possible harassment north of Gunnison.
- 12-02-19 Deputies responded to take a cold report of property damage south of town.
- 12-02-19 Deputies assisted the Gunnison Police department for a welfare check on a person who appeared to have frostbitten feet. This person went to the hospital for medical attention.
- 12-02-19 Deputies patrolling south of Gunnison stopped a person who was speeding. Deputies issued a ticket for failure to provide registration for their vehicle.
