## **For Immediate Release- Update**

November 17, 2024  
Marble, CO

The following update below has been provided by the Incident Command team.

“The Colorado State Patrol HazMat Team has determined the safest way to resolve this incident is to have a specially trained technician repair the broken valve on the propane truck. This repair will take place Monday, November 18, followed immediately by recovery operations. Firefighters will remain on scene throughout the process.

This work requires a full closure of County Road 3 between mile posts 0.5 – 1.5 during the operation.

### **Road Closure Details for Monday, November 18**

- County Road 3 will be fully closed from 9:00 AM to at least 3:00 PM, with the possibility of extending to 6:00 PM depending on the repair and recovery timeline.
- No evacuations are necessary during this process.
- Highway 133 will not be impacted.

We will share updates here and through Pitkin Alert if any changes to this plan occur.

Once the truck has been safely removed, County Road 3 will be fully reopened.

We recognize the seriousness of this situation and understand the disruption it has caused, especially for our neighbors in Marble and Gunnison County. Your patience, understanding, and cooperation have been truly appreciated as we work to resolve this safely.”
