

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

RESOLUTION NO. 88-28

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING INDIVIDUAL SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS ON
LESS THAN ONE-ACRE SITES.

WHEREAS, Section IV(4) of the Gunnison County Sanitary Sewer Resolution provides that the Gunnison County Board of Health shall approve, deny or conditionally approve certain applications to construct or install individual sewage disposal systems on sites less than one acre; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Environmental Health has the expertise to take such action themselves rather than just make recommendations; and

WHEREAS, this Board has always relied upon and adopted the recommendations of the Board of Environmental Health and has never refused to accept such recommendations; and

WHEREAS, requiring such applications to be approved by the Board of Health only delays their issuance, which delay can be avoided by authorizing the Board of Environmental Health to issue permits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Gunnison County, Colorado:

1. The Gunnison County Board of Environmental Health is hereby authorized to approve and issue permits for the construction of individual sewage disposal systems on sites of less than one acre. Such authority includes the authority to deny applications for such permits or to approve such applications with conditions.
2. Any person dissatisfied with the action of the Board of Environmental Health may appeal such action to the Board of Health, provided:
 - a. The appeal is filed in writing; and
 - b. The appeal is filed within ten (10) days of the action of the Board of Environmental Health.
