**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING COLLABORATION AMONG  
GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES IN THE VALLEY IN PROMOTING PUBLIC  
AWARENESS VIA EDUCATION AND OUTREACH TO REDUCE ENERGY  
CONSUMPTION THEREBY INCREASING QUALITY OF LIFE,  
ENVIRONMENTAL AND ECONOMIC BENEFITS TO THE CITIZENS OF  
THE GUNNISON VALLEY**

**WHEREAS**, community leaders of both governmental and non-governmental public organizations in the Gunnison Valley have signed agreements pledging institutional changes to improve energy efficiency, reduce carbon emissions, protect air and water quality and enhance economic viability; and

**WHEREAS**, existing and potential programs involving energy efficiency are most effective if coordinated among many participating institutions and agencies with respect to information and resource sharing; and

**WHEREAS**, many towns, cities and counties throughout the nation, both large and small are providing economic and quality of life benefits such as reduced energy bills, green space preservation, air quality improvements, reduced traffic congestion and improved transportation choices; and

**WHEREAS**, Gunnison County is a political subdivision of the State of Colorado; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Crested Butte, Colorado is a home rule municipality, duly and regularly organized and now validly existing as a body corporate and politic under and by virtue of the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Mt. Crested Butte, Colorado is a home rule municipality, duly and regularly organized and now validly existing as a body corporate and politic under and by virtue of the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gunnison, Colorado is a municipal corporation duly and regularly organized and operating under a home rule charter of the Constitution of the State of Colorado; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the governmental agencies in the Gunnison Valley that each will take a leadership role in promoting public awareness about the benefits of reduced energy consumption and actions to address it, including:

1. Each governmental agency will coordinate their efforts with other participating governmental and non-governmental agencies in the valley so there is a common set of standards and goals to be achieved; and



2. The governmental agencies will appoint a representative to serve on a temporary energy task force, which may include other stakeholders as appropriate, to develop an education and outreach plan.
3. That the temporary energy task force will make recommendations to each governmental agency for the implementation and ongoing evaluation of energy reduction goals.


